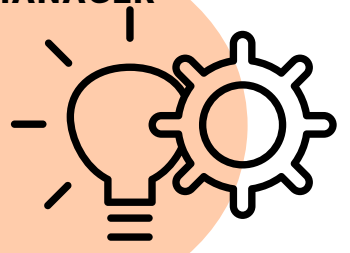

- Thinking: Learning the basics of project management, focusing on task completion and coordination.



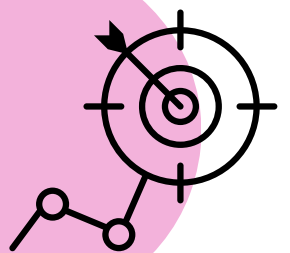
### 2. PROJECT MANAGER

- Thinking: Tactical mindset, focusing on day-to-day operations, timelines, and resource allocation.



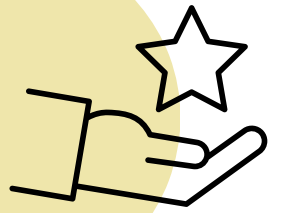
### 3. SENIOR PROJECT MANAGER

- Thinking: Developing strategic thinking skills, understanding project alignment with organizational goals.



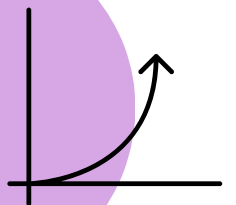
### 4. PROGRAM MANAGER

- Thinking: Strategic mindset, balancing priorities across projects, understanding interdependencies.



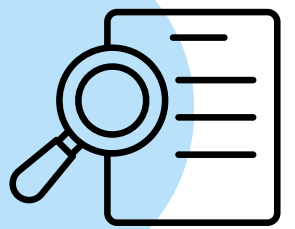
### 5. PORTFOLIO MANAGER

- Thinking: Strategic planning, prioritizing projects based on their contribution to overall business goals.



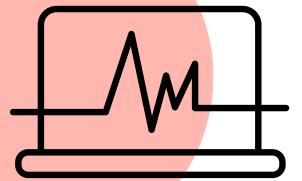
### 6. DIRECTOR OF PROJECT MANAGEMENT/PMO DIRECTOR:
